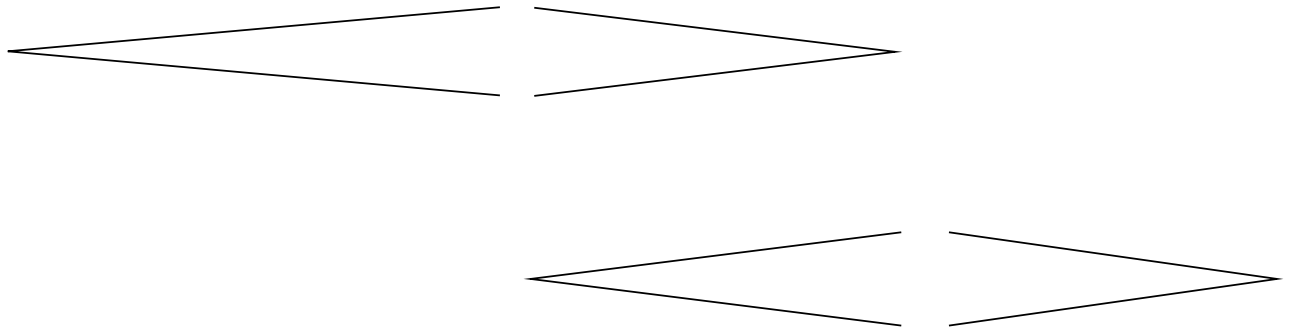


(B) All singers: One by one, start singing the phrase below independently, freely, at a leisurely pace. Sing about four times, fading the last time




